

The RHS Kiltie Band staff is planning a trip for the 2024-2025 school year, and we have tentatively accepted an invitation for the Kilties to travel to London for the

London New Year's Day Parade on January 1, 2025!!!

The Kilties would fly to London on Saturday, <u>December 28, 2024</u>, and would return to Florida on Saturday, <u>January 4, 2025</u>, for a trip spanning 8 days and 7 nights. <u>This trip is over Winter Break</u> and students would not miss any school days. Cost includes Airfare, Bus, Hotel, Breakfast (6), Dinner (6), Lunch (1), Tours of: The West End, Tower of London, Windsor and Oxford, a boat cruise on the River Thames, New Year's Eve Party,

and more! More details on an itinerary will follow as they become available.

In order to properly plan, we need to know how many students can commit to a trip cost of approximately \$3685 per student (DOUBLE occupancy). We have already started fundraising to give students ample time to help raise funds. Limited Trip insurance is included

Payment Schedule:

FIRST DEPOSIT	\$200 per person by: December 1st 2023
SECOND DEPOSIT	\$400 per person by: March 1st 2024
THIRD DEPOSIT	\$600 per person by: June 1st 2024
FOURTH DEPOSIT	\$800 per person by: September 1st 2024
FINAL BALANCE (plus or minus any variation in sirline, airport, & government taxes fees charges and surcharges)	Balancing payment per person by NOVEMBER 5th 2024

Note: You may always pay earlier than the deadline. <u>The boosters cannot issue refunds.</u> Any claims must be made through the trip insurance.
